ARTICLE I: Name of Organization

- This organization shall be called the Bible Club.

ARTICLE II: Purpose/Objectives

- The purpose of the Bible Club is to promote a comfortable environment for Biblical discussion.
- The Bible Club will also provide fun challenges to increase knowledge of the Bible.

ARTICLE III: Membership

- All faiths and non-faiths are welcomed as members.
- Only currently enrolled students are permitted to be members or officers.
- There will be no formal initiation of members.

ARTICLE IV: Faculty/Staff Advisor

- The advisor is chosen by the discussion leader and assistant/co-leader.
- The advisor must ensure that the Bible Club accomplishes its purpose and abides by all CSU regulations.
- The advisor may feel free to participate in all discussions and activities.

ARTICLE V: Officers

- The Bible Club will be headed by a discussion leader and an assistant or co-leader.
- The discussion leader may be chosen by majority vote of the members present at the time of the vote (the time of the vote will be announced in advance) OR by appointment of the previous leader.
- The assistant/co-leader to the discussion leader will also be chosen by majority vote OR by appointment of the discussion leader.
- The position of assistant or co-leader is optional to the Bible Club.
- Additional assistants may be added as necessary.

ARTICLE VI: Meetings

- The members of the Bible Club will meet a minimum of one day per week (there may be exceptions).
- The Bible Club may meet more than once a week if the members vote to do so.
- Attendance is not mandatory for members of the Bible Club.

ARTICLE VII: Finance

- No dues are required, but donations are accepted.
- The discussion leader may choose to require dues if he/she desires.

ARTICLE VIII: Amendments

- Any major amendments to the Constitution of the Bible Club will be made by majority vote of the members present at the time of the vote.
