### Old vs. New Testament

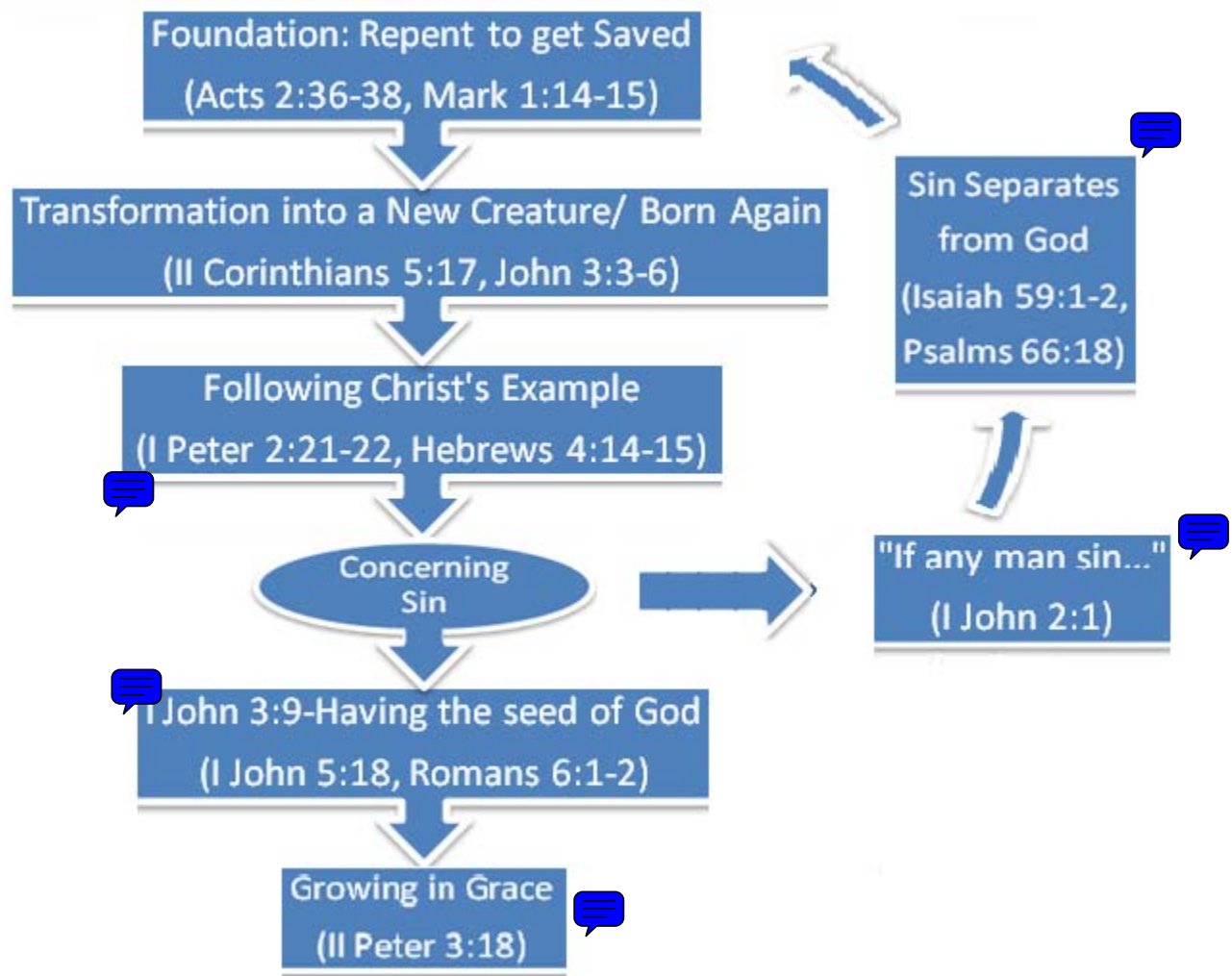
#### **Old Testament**

-Hebrews 10:1-4- they had to constantly make sacrifices for sin in the Old Testament because they could not live without sin on a consistent basis (those who lived during this time were righteous by the OT standard)

#### **New Testament** (our standard)

-Matthew 1:21- Jesus broke the power of sin when He came

-Romans 6:12-15- now that we are under grace, sin no longer has dominion over a Christian (dominion- the power or right of governing and controlling; sovereign authority)



\*these are not necessarily steps, but a chain of thought
