

## The Creation

- The Story (Genesis 1:1-31, 2:1-3)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Day: Day and Night created
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Day: firmament (sky called Heaven)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Day: Earth (land), Seas (gathering of the waters), and plants (grass, herbs, fruit, trees)
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Day: sun, moon, and stars (2 great lights for seasons, days, and years and to divide Day and Night)
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Day: sea animals and fowls (birds)
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Day: land animals (cattle, creeping things, and beasts) and mankind
  - 7<sup>th</sup> Day: God rested from all of His work
- Creation of Man (Genesis 2:7-8, 15-25)
  - created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26-27)
  - became a living soul (Genesis 2:7)
  - woman created from man (Genesis 2:18, 20-24)
  - given dominion over the earth (Genesis 1:26, 28)
  - man responsible to dress and keep the garden (Genesis 2:15)
  - man responsible to name the animals (Genesis 2:20)
  - restricted from the tree of knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 2:16-17)
- Fall of Man (Genesis 3:1-13)
  - mankind tricked by the serpent
  - sin entered the world through disobedience
  - man, woman, and serpent cursed as a result
- The Curse (Genesis 3:14-24)
  - serpent: cursed to crawl on his belly and be at enmity with mankind (verses 14-15)
  - woman: sorrow in childbearing and husband has the rule (verse 16)
  - man: must work by the sweat of his brow (verses 17-19)
  - all of mankind: death (Genesis 3:19, 22-24) and sin (Romans 5:12, 18-19) enter the world
  - Adam and Eve kicked out of the garden (Genesis 3:23-24)
- Now...
  - mankind needs to pray (Genesis 4:25-26, Luke 18:1)
  - Jesus had to come to bring redemption to mankind (Hebrews 9:11-12)
